

Mounting Recommendation

To minimize or avoid shock and/or vibration stresses to terminating wires and solder connections we recommend to fix voluminous resin-potted MP capacitors as from e.g. PCM 22.5 mm in an appropriate way since for constructional reasons they do not sit tight on the hoard






Typical Graphs of the Capacitor Paper **Dielectric**






Capacitance change versus temperature (f=1 kHz) (general guide)

In practice a preheating duration of t < 5 min. has been proven to be best.






Diagram 2: PCM 10/15 mm
